## Ice Art

### Equipment:

Freezer container  
Boiled water (cooled)  
String  
Leaves, flowers, seeds

### What you need to do:

- 1 Collect some leaves, flowers or seeds or whatever you think will look good in your ice art
- 2 Place these in your freezer container
- 3 Add the boiled water to the container and make sure the leaves, flowers etc are under the surface of the water
- 4 Place a loop of string into the end of the container. Make sure some of the string is out of the water so that you can use it to hang your ice art up
- 5 Leave in the freezer overnight
- 6 Take your container out of the freezer and remove the ice block
- 7 Hang it out in your garden on the fence or on a tree so that it catches the sunlight.
