Snuffling Hedgehog

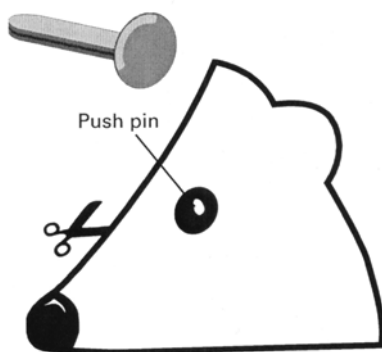
How to make your hedgehog:

You will need: corrugated cardboard, a black pen, two paper fasteners and sellotape or glue.

Using the template, draw two hedgehog shapes on corrugated cardboard. Turn the template over for one of the hedgehogs so that your two hedgehogs face in opposite directions. Cut out the shapes.

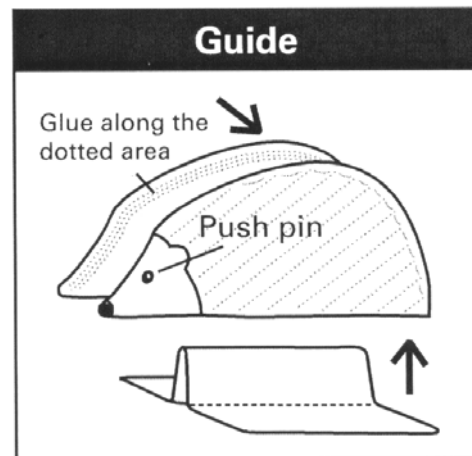
Next, cut out two hedgehog heads from corrugated cardboard – don't forget to reverse the template again.

Draw in the eye and nose on the two heads, then fix the sides of the head to the corrugated sides of the body with two paper fasteners – you might need to ask an adult to help you.



Tape the ends of the nose together with sellotape.

Glue or tape the hedgehog sides together along the top of the hedgehog. Make sure the corrugated sides face outwards. Leave the flat bottom of the hedgehog unglued.



Make a stand for your hedgehog using a piece of card – 6 cm square. Fold it as shown in the diagram, and then slot the hedgehog on top of it.

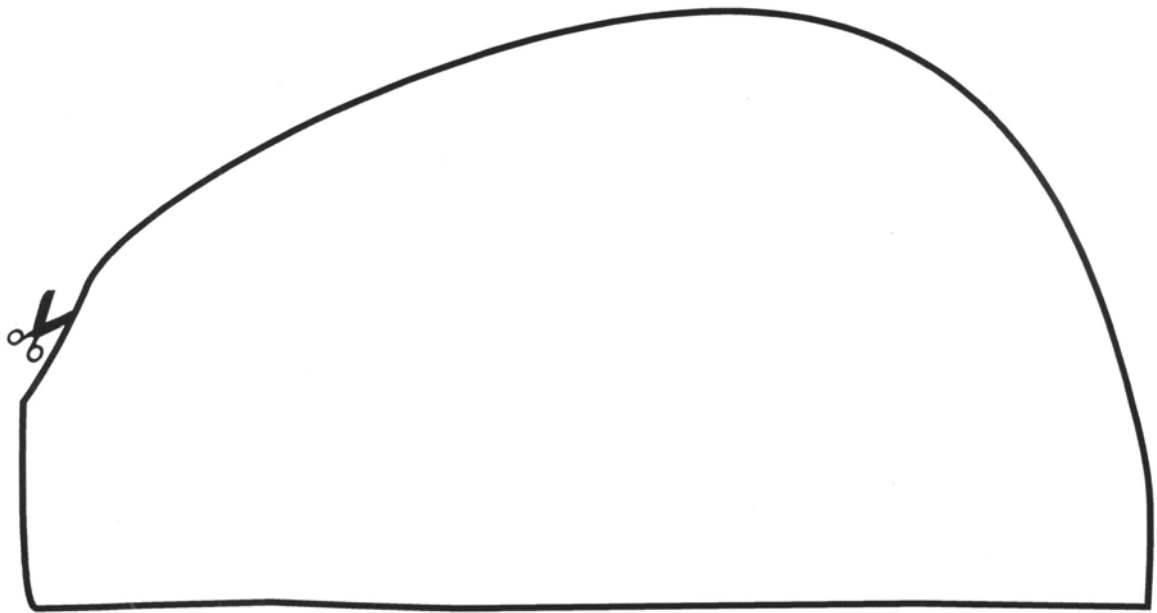
Move the hedgehog's head to make it snuffle!
