- Certain sensitive local populations are excluded from public display
- Each year, County Bird Recorders and Local Bird Clubs can inform the BCTP of local populations of sensitive species, which should be excluded from public display during the target map update
- Target maps will be held confidentially within the BCTP partnership at 2 km resolution
