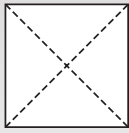




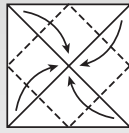

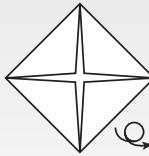
How to make your crafty quiz



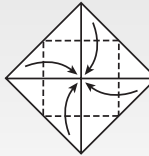
1 With blank side facing you, fold on the diagonals.



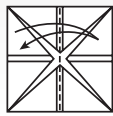
2 Unfold, then fold each corner to meet in the middle



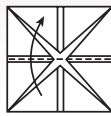
3 Turn paper over.



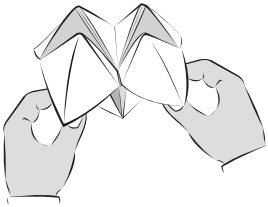
4 Fold all corners into the middle again, on this side.



5 Fold paper in half and unfold.



6 Fold in half from top to bottom.



7 Put your thumbs and forefingers into the flaps and move the quizzier back and forth to play.

How to play

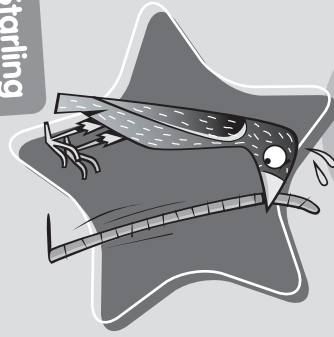
- Put your thumb and forefinger of each hand in the four flaps of the crafty quiz and push the points together.
- Choose one of the birds.
- Spell out the name of the bird by opening and shutting the quizzier forwards and sideways. Move once for every letter in the name.
- Pick a number and move the quizzier for the same number of times.
- Pick another number, open up the flap and answer the question.
