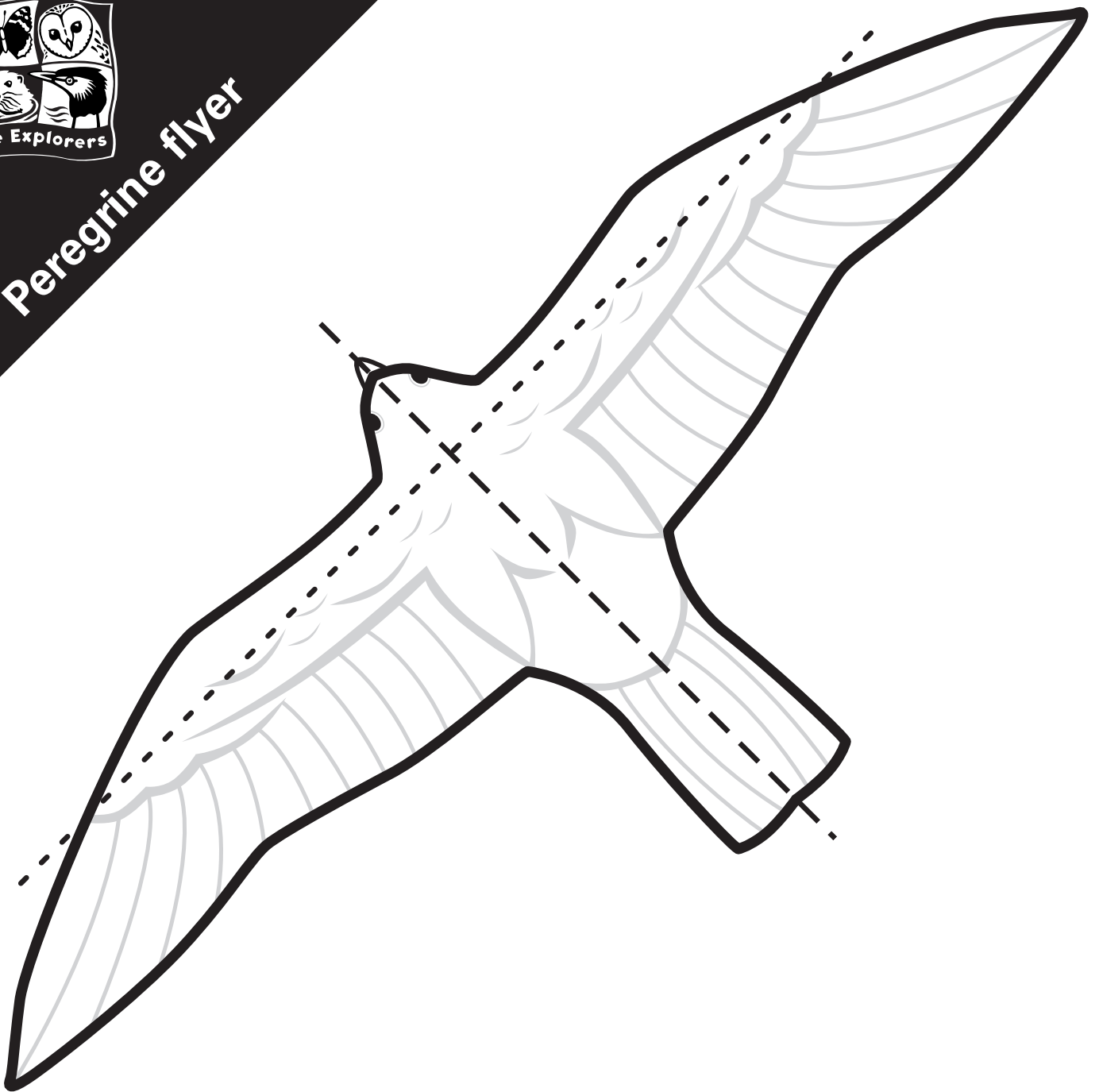
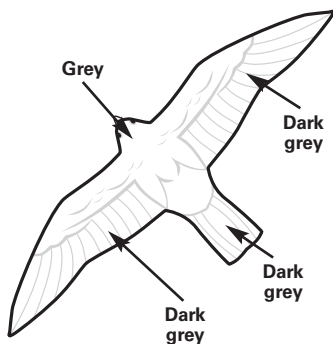




# Peregrine flyer



## Colouring guide



## Information for activity leader:

Photocopy this template onto card for the best effect.

## You will need:

- Scissors
- Paper clip

## What to do:

- Cut out your peregrine outline and colour in.
- Fold the front edge of the wings downwards along the dotted line.
- Fold body into a shallow 'v' along dashed line.
- Put paperclip on front and fly your peregrine; you may need to adjust the weight.

Female peregrines lay 3-4 eggs in spring and both parents share the task of keeping them warm, which is called 'incubation'.
