Recycled bird feeder

What you will need:

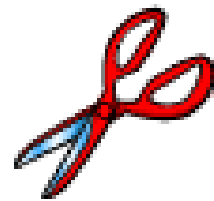
Large plastic bottle (clean)

Wire or string

Scissors

Bird seed

- 1 Cut a hole half way up the side of the bottle. Large enough for the birds to get the seeds out, but not too big that the seeds fall out when the wind blows.
- 2 Make small holes in the bottom of the bottle so that any rain water will drain away and not make the seeds soggy.
- 3 Tie the string or wire tightly around the bottle top and leave enough extra string to tie it onto a tree, the side of your shed or washing line.
- 4 Fill with bird seed up to the opening of the hole.
- 5 Watch the birds come and feed.
