

# Finding your way around RSPB Fairburn Ings

■ **Discovery trail**

**This 0.3 mile (500m) flat trail is great for buggies and wheelchairs and wheelchairs.**  
Stop off at Pickup hide and watch for grey herons and lapwings. Try pond dipping, and then call in at the visitor centre to see the birds at the feeders.

**It takes about one hour to walk this 2 mile (3 km) trail (one way).**  
Wildflowers grow in summer and fly agarics in autumn. Stroll to Cut Lane to spot kingfishers, and visit Charlie's hide to view great crested grebes.

**This 1.5 mile (2.4 km) trail takes 45 minutes, or you can extend your walk along the Lin Dike link.**  
In summer, skylarks sing high in the sky and dragonflies dart around. Look out for reed buntings in the reedbeds.

**This 1.5 mile (2.4 km) path links Lin Dike to the rest of the reserve and takes about 45 minutes to walk (one way).**  
Enjoy an amble along the banks of the river. Look for butterflies in summer and herons in winter.

**This one way 0.6 mile (1 km) trail from Lin Dike car park joins with the Lin Dike link and the path into Castleford.**  
This path gives great views of the wetland, and you could see waders, ducks, geese and swans.
