Finding your way around

Nature trail

Dive deeper into the marsh on this 2 mile (3.2 km) route. You'll walk past lagoons, grazing marsh and meadows on your way to the sea wall. The trail is hard surfaced and accessible with the exception of the sea wall access, where the surface is steep and more uneven.












Dog walking trail

Especially for our four-legged friends, this route is 0.5 miles (0.8 km) long – great for a quick stretch. Please keep your dog on a lead at all times and come prepared to take any dog waste away with you.

Discovery trail

This 0.9 mile (1.5 km) trail is perfect for the whole family to explore the reserve. Enjoy the playground and view from the Red Hill. The trail is mostly hard-surfaced with grass paths to the top of the hill and slight slopes in some places.
