Collect all **six issues** of Wild Explorer this year and make this amazing model of a peregrine falcon!

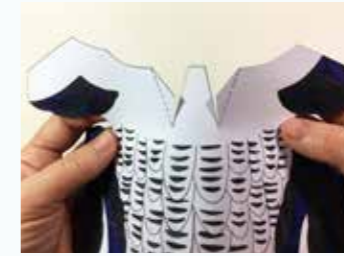


PART ONE

Step by step

Cut out the body shape and be careful not to cut off the tabs. Back it with paper or card.



1 Cut the slits on either side of the neck. Only cut along the solid lines.



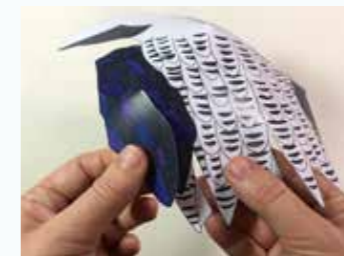
2 Cut slits on either side of the body, on the outside edge of the white.



3 Fold the neck tabs (1) along the dotted line and glue in place.



4 When both sides are glued you should have a shaped neck.



5 Glue the coloured section of the body in place over the white section on both sides.



6 Glue the bottom tabs (2) in place. Each tab fits behind the feather next to it.



7 Finally, glue the body together at the back using the three tabs (3).



8 Now your body is finished! Keep it in a safe place for next issue.
