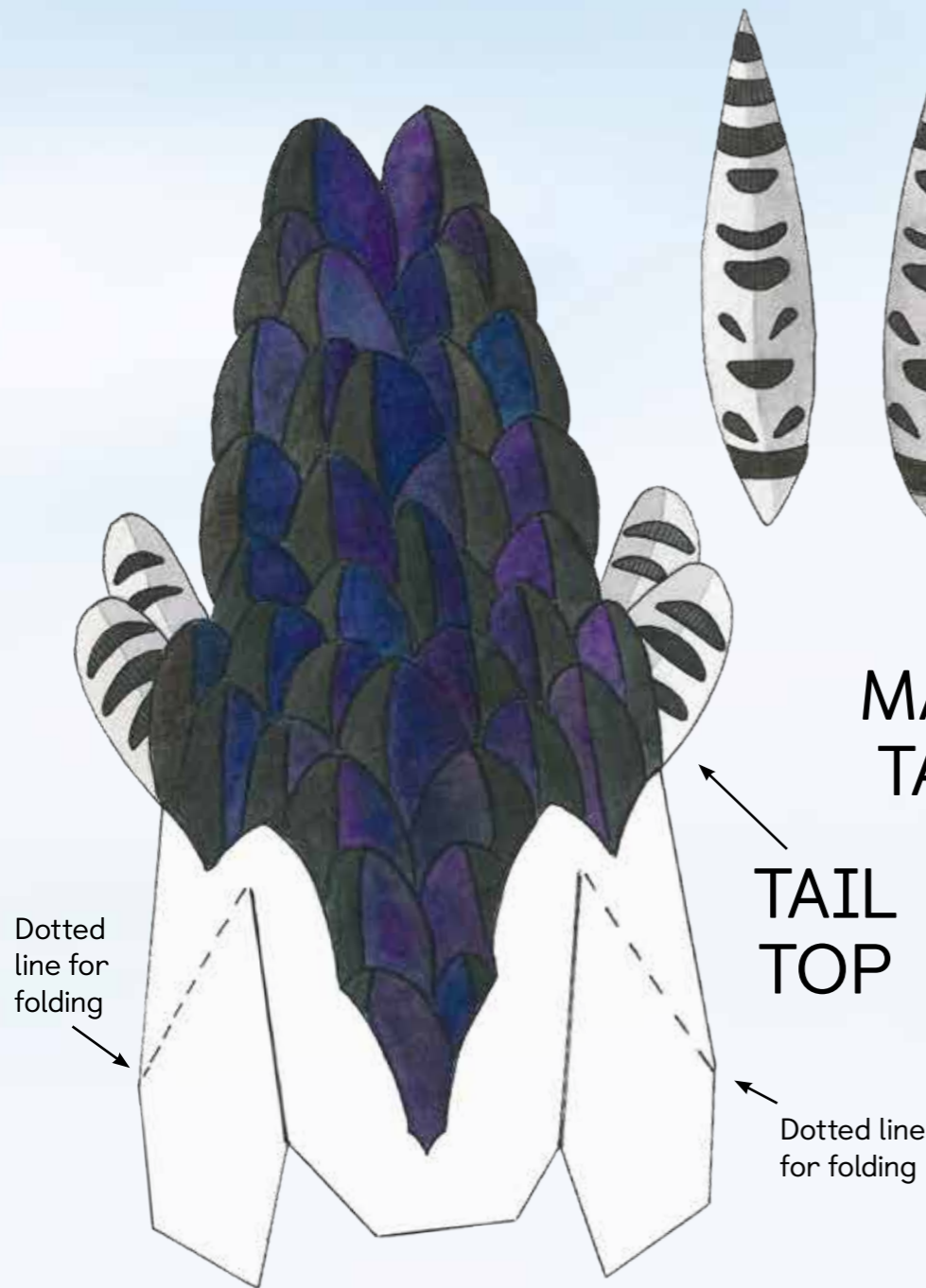


# PEREGRINE FALCON

## Step by step

Cut out the tail, being careful not to cut off the tabs. Back it with paper or card.



**1** Fold the main tail in half and glue it together.



**2** Fold in the slits in the tail top so the dotted lines meet. Glue in place.



**3** Fold the white part of the tail base underneath and stick it together with the tabs.



**4** Put glue on the narrow end of the main tail and stick it to the matching shape on the tail base.



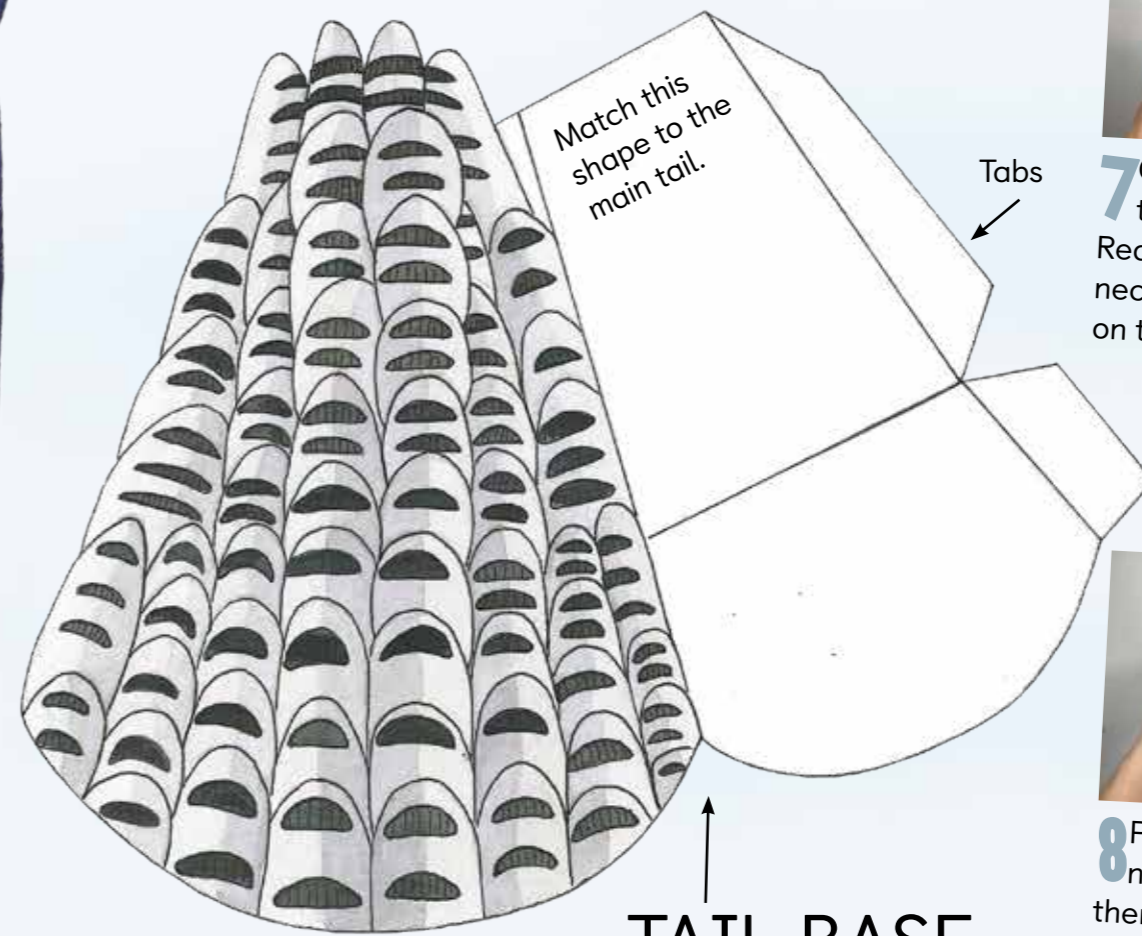
**5** The tail top now goes on the opposite side to the tail base. Glue it in place by wrapping the two side feathers on the tail top around onto the tail base.



**6** Use the two separate feathers to cover up the join.



**7** Carefully slide the tail through the body. Reach in through the neck and tape it in place on the inside.



**8** Put glue on the two neck tabs and fold them round to make a smaller neck.
