

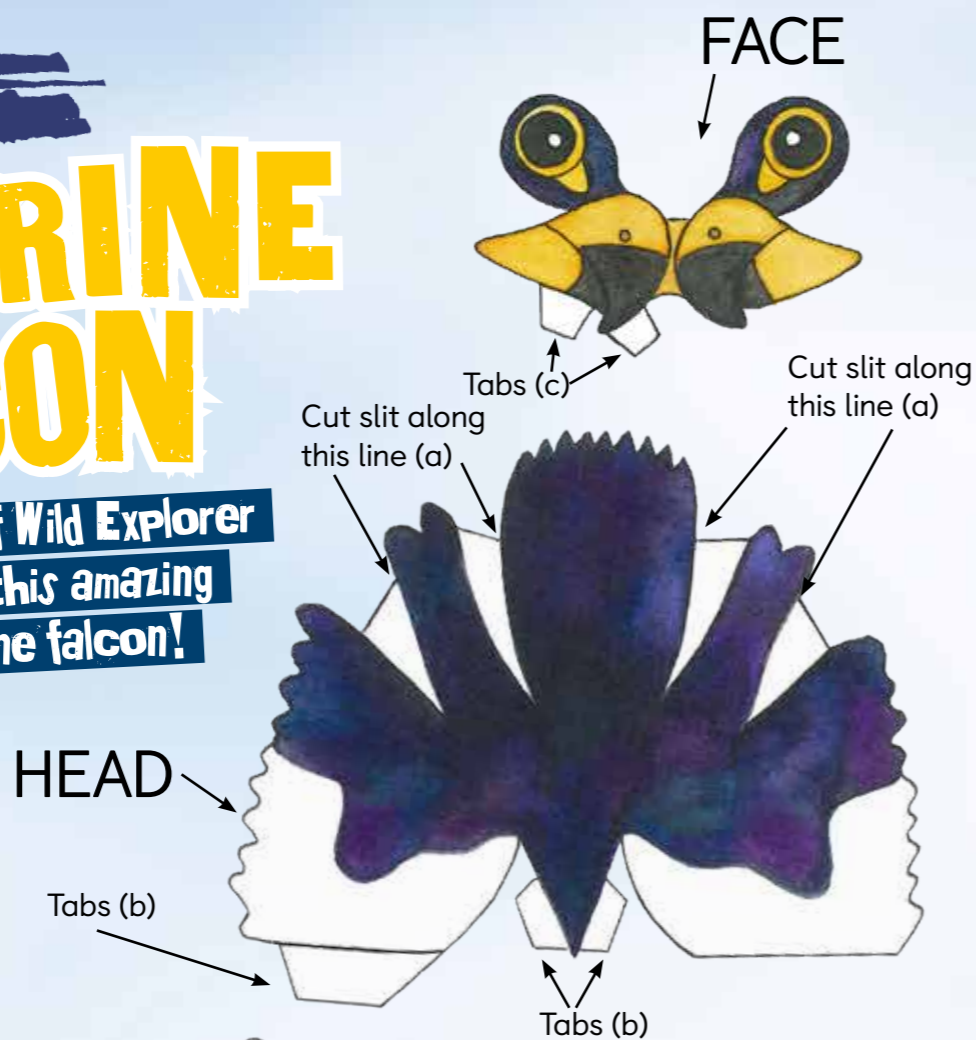
BUILD A BIRD

PEREGRINE FALCON

PART SIX

Attach wings



1 Line up the left wing with the body and tape in place.



2 Stick the left wing joiner over the join to hide the tape and add strength. Wrap around to the front. Repeat for right wing.

RIGHT WING JOINER

Step by step

Cut out these pieces and back them with paper or card. Don't cut off any tabs.



1 Where you cut slits (a) on the head, put glue on the white triangles (b) and fold them round and stick in place and fold over the blue.



2 Put glue on the tabs (b) and fold them round and stick in place to shape the head.



3 Put glue on the face tabs (c) and use them to stick the two sides of the face together.



4 Put glue on the back of the eyes and attach to the head. Then glue the head on to the neck.



5 Concertina fold the feet. Glue together just the black claws.



6 Fold the leg in half. Put glue on the bottom half and stick over the feet.

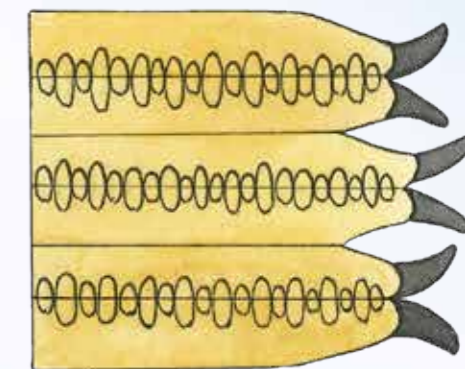
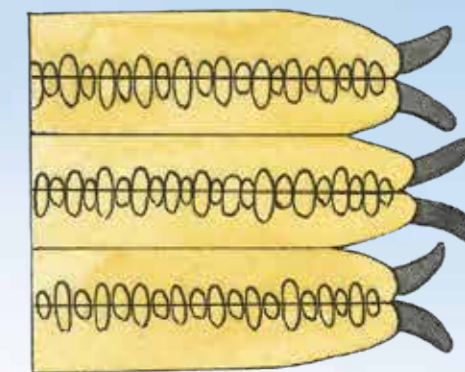


7 When dry, open out the top of the leg a little. Stick the leg feathers over the top of the legs.



8 Put glue on the back of the leg feathers and glue them on to the body.
