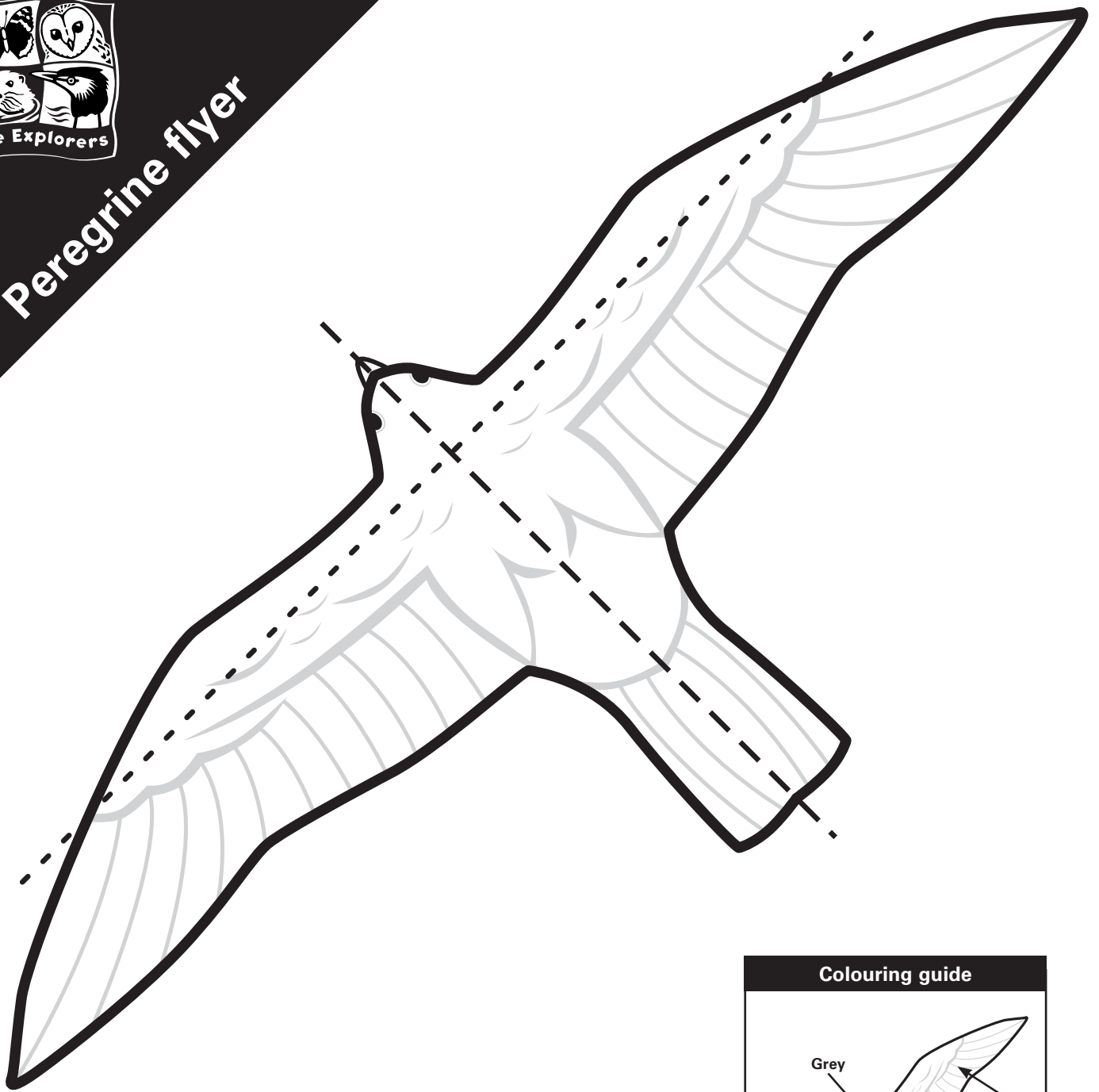




# Peregrine flyer



## Information for activity leader:

Photocopy this template onto card for the best effect.

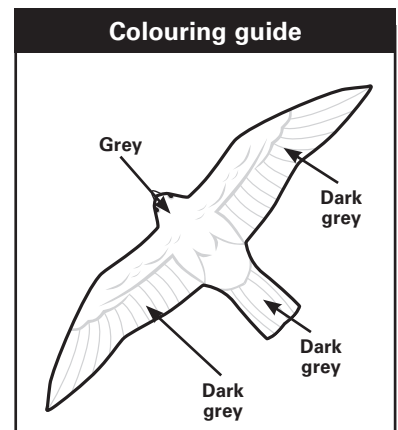
## You will need:

- Scissors
- Paper clip

## What to do:

- Cut out your peregrine outline and colour in.
- Fold the front edge of the wings downwards along the dotted line.
- Fold body into a shallow 'v' along dashed line.
- Put the paper clip on the front and fly your peregrine. You may need to adjust the weight.
