

# Welcome to RSPB Garston Wood

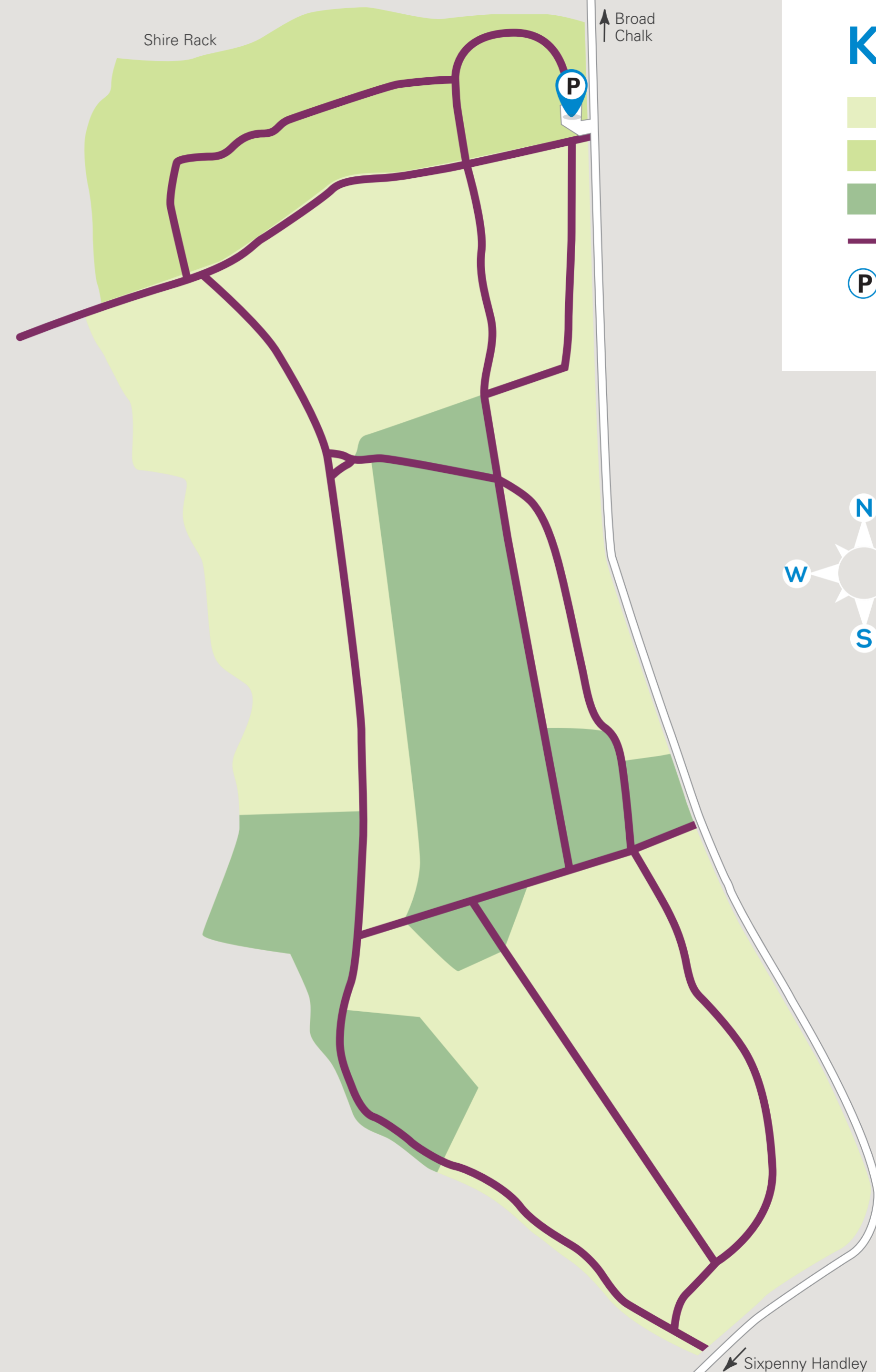
## Explore this ancient woodland gem

RSPB Garston Wood is a small, quiet reserve, with no visitor centre. You may even have it to yourself! There's a network of paths and rides criss-crossing the wood for you to explore.

To the north, a relatively open area of low scrub is a great place to spot butterflies and other insects.

In the centre is the 'high wood', an area with larger older trees – look here for woodland birds and for fallow and roe deer.

Surrounding the 'high wood' is the hazel coppice, which is in a constant cutting cycle, each area being cut every 15 years or so. This is home to an array of wildflowers and our elusive dormice.
